

## **Environmental Policy Statement**

The Moredun Foundation is a registered charity that exists to promote the highest possible standards for animal health and welfare through research and education and is dedicated to the cure or prevention of disease. The Foundation is head of the following Group of companies based at Pentlands Science Park.

Moredun Research Institute carries out development and completion of research projects to improve animal health and welfare, production of information for public dissemination and the provision of diagnostic.

Moredun Scientific provides testing services to the animal health, pharmaceutical and biotechnology industries supporting the development, registration and manufacture of medicinal products.

Pentlands Science Park Limited administers all the Park's property and facilities and management services in such areas as security, engineering, IT, waste disposal, stores, catering and conferencing.

In completing its work, the Moredun Group acts to prevent pollution and minimize impact on the environment and regularly assesses and reviews these environmental impacts that its activities may cause. Operational control procedures are in place to achieve continual environmental improvement within Moredun's Environmental Management System. Resources are made available to implement and maintain this policy. The review of environmental objectives is carried out regularly at quarterly meetings of the Environment Protection Advisory Group (EPAG) and minutes published on the Moredun intranet. These meetings regularly review changes in work activities which affect the environment and use new and existing activities as the framework for implementation of the environmental policy.

Moredun complies with all relevant legislation and regulatory requirements, as well as to the other requirements to which it subscribes.

The policy is communicated to all members of staff, with relevant training provided to increase environmental awareness and reduce pollution throughout the group of companies.

The policy is also communicated to the public by means including the Moredun group websites and annual report. A report on the management of significant environmental aspects will be published in the annual report.
