



Moredun Group Net Zero Emissions Target Statement

The Moredun Group recognises the global climate emergency and is committed to paying its part in Scotland's national endeavour to end our contribution to climate change within a generation. To ensure the Moredun Group contributes to leadership in this effort, we adopt the following minimum targets and dates:

- Achieve net zero emissions across our direct Scope 1 emissions, indirect Scope 2 and Scope 3 emissions including (water, waste, business travel, staff commuting and homeworking, upstream leased assets, purchased goods and services, capital goods) by (2045 – or such other earlier date if possible).
- Decarbonise the heating in our buildings, in line with the phased targets for publically-owned buildings by (2038 at the latest).
- Removing petrol & diesel cars owned by the Moredun Group by 2030 and adding no new petrol or diesel light commercial vehicles (from 2030).
- Reduce the distance our staff travel by petrol or diesel car, both for business travel and commuting by 20% by 2030 (compared to a 2024 baseline).
- Send no biodegradable waste to landfill (by 2025) and send zero waste to landfill (by 2030).
- Ensure our investment decisions, including procurement, are aligned with Scotland's net zero targets and support the move to a circular economy.
- Maximise opportunities to enhance and restore biodiversity on our estate.
- Ensure adaptation to the impacts of climate change alongside our efforts to reduce our emissions as far as we can, as fast as we can.
